2nd Kaiser/Fontana Invitational Band Review

INFORMATION SHEET

GENERAL

The 2nd Kaiser/Fontana Invitational Band Review will be held Saturday, September 17, 2011, 9:00 a.m. at the Auto Club Speedway, 9300 Cherry Ave., Fontana, California. The *Band Review* will feature up to 40 high school and junior high/middle school bands.

APPLICATION

The application deadline for the Kaiser/Fontana Invitational Band Review is Monday, *August 27, 2011*. If you are unable to obtain the entry fee and/or photograph in time to make the deadline, please submit your application anyway with a note that there is more to follow. A receipt for your application, music, entry fee, and any other material will be mailed or emailed.

ENTRY FEE

A non-refundable entry fee is required to participate. The fee will be **\$200** (additional \$50 for drill team). Checks should be made payable to:

Kaiser High School Band.

BASIS FOR ADJUDICATION

We will be adhering to the rules and guidelines of the *Southern California School Band and Orchestra Association (SCSBOA)* for band reviews, as set forth in the *SCSBOA PARADE GUIDE*, and will be using SCSBOA judges. Copies of this manual are available for purchase from SCSBOA, 11770 Warner Ave., Suite 110, Fountain Valley, CA 92708.

CLASSIFICATION

The Band Review will be classified based on *past performance history* with the assistance of the Head Judge.

AWARDS

The awards ceremony will begin at approximately 11:00 a.m. at the Kaiser High School Football Stadium.

The awards will be as follows: Band Sweepstakes, MS Band Sweepstakes, Auxiliary Sweepstakes, MS Auxiliary Sweepstakes, HS Music Award, and MS Music Award. Awards for various classes of Band, Drill Team, Auxiliary, and Drum Major Awards will be determined by the number of entries received.

TIE SCORES

In the event of a tie, *duplicate trophies will be awarded* for that place and the next lower place(s) will be eliminated. For example, a two-way tie for first place would result in awarding 1st-1st-3rd-4th place trophies. A tie for the last awarded trophy or any special category awards (e.g., Music Award, High Showmanship) will result in duplicate trophies being awarded.

BAND REVIEW PARADE ROUTE

The route takes place in the parking lot of the Auto Club Speedway. Maps will be provided in advance and signs will mark the staging areas, route, and parking areas.

BAND REVIEW MUSIC SCORES

SCSBOA rules require all Band Review participants to provide two <u>legal</u> copies of their competition march conductor's score. If originals are not available photocopies may be used so long as they are accompanied by a letter from the publisher granting permission to photocopy. These *scores must be received no later than September 10, 2011.* Refer to SCSBOA PARADE GUIDE. §2.3.1 Failure to receive music scores by this deadline will result in a *5.0 penalty* off the band score.

CHECK-IN/STAGING

The check-in table will be located in the parking lot of the Auto Club Speedway. Buses will be directed to the staging area where the students will unload, then the buses will be directed to parking near the end of the parade route to await the students for eventual boarding and transport to the Awards Ceremony at Kaiser High School. More specific information, including maps and diagrams, will be provided prior to the event.

RESTROOMS

Restrooms will be located on the Kaiser High School campus as well as in the staging area at the Auto Club Speedway.

BUS PARKING

Bus Parking will be located first at the Auto Club Speedway, then the buses will transport the students and park at Kaiser High School.

INFORMATION/FIRST AID STATION

There will be a first aid station for the duration of the event. Please contact the Check-in Stand if you need these services during warm-up and formation times.

LOST AND FOUND

The Lost and Found Area will be immediately adjacent to the Information/First Aid Station.

NO SMOKING

Smoking is not permitted in the stands, restrooms, or other areas on the Kaiser High School campus.

FOOD CONCESSIONS

The use of barbeques or other cooking equipment is **PROHIBITED** in the parking lot of the Auto Club Speedway and on the Kaiser High School campus. The Kaiser High School Boosters will be selling reasonably priced food in the Kaiser High School Stadium area. We hope that you will support their fund-raising efforts by allowing your students to take advantage of this opportunity.

ADMISSION PRICES

The Band Review is open to the public at no charge.
